What You'll Do

You will lead the delivery of design and build workplace projects typically between £1M and £5M, taking responsibility from preconstruction through to final handover. Most importantly, you should be someone who values professional, thoughtful delivery, remains calm under pressure, and wants to work in a business that takes quality seriously rather than cutting corners.
